- 192 +- deviation of new archers which may be approximately 20 archers.
- For induction into NCOE/KIA, top archers of recurve/ compound event & top archers of Indian round are based on the ranking of commutative points earned in the ranking & elimination round Except for archers from FINAL NRAT & FINAL WNRAT, upon successful completion of age verification test.
- From NRAT/WNRAT top archers will be based on the elimination round ranking upon successful completion of the age verification test
- After Removing KIA/Dev. athletes, From the long list of athletes:
  - An athlete will be inducted post allotting rank after analyzing the average score in the competitions/selection trials in the past 1 year for both KIA & NCOE inductions.
  - The athlete will be inducted as per his/her rank against the available vacancy in his/her category post clearance of AVT & remaining athletes can be waitlisted till further vacancies arise in the future.
  - Athletes upto the age of 26 years will be inducted under the Khelo India & NCOE Scheme. However, promising athletes performing well at international competitions can be inducted into the scheme subject to recommendations by TIDC based on the last 2 years performance.
- First priority will be given to Khelo India athletes for induction into NOCEs.
- In exceptional cases we may induct between 14 to 16 years if the concerned archers shows promising performance in any of the KI tournaments and the coaches of the concerned NCOE approve of the same or the Foreign Coach at the NCOE / appointed recommends the same. Once selected he/she shall follow the career progression norms.

#### Notes:

- 1. **KI:** Any archer who has not participated in the last year in any of the following competitons: 4 NRATs, Sr/Jr/Sub Junior National Championship/ Selection Trials –will be weeded out.
- 2. NCOE: Any archer who has not participated in the last year in any of the following competitions: 4 NRATs, Sr/Jr/Sub Junior National Championship/ Selection will be weeded out.
- 3. KIA has to attend both assessment camps compulsorily. If an archer fails to attend any one performance assessment camp then justification is to be submitted for not attending the camp. And, if an archer fails to attend both performance assessment camps, it will lead to weeding out from Khelo India scheme irrespective of his justification & performance as per benchmark.
- 4. Relaxation as detailed in Table "A" from benchamrk as listed in Table "B" will be given to athletes for a maximum of 6 months from the date of evaluation after issuing warning letter. However, if the performance of the athlete in concern doesn't improve then they may be weeded out post recommendation of TIDC.

- a. Athletes identified from International tournaments as defined in Induction & Weed out protocols.
- b. Athletes identified from National tournaments as defined in Induction & Weed out protocols.
- c. Athletes Identified from Khelo India Youth games as defined in Induction & Weed out protocols
- d. Athletes Identified from NRAT & WNRAT as defined in Induction & Weed out protocols.

## 6. Selection of NCOE athletes will be done as follows:

- a. Athletes Identified for Khelo India scheme
- b. Waitlisted athletes for Khelo India Scheme







- c. Athletes identified from defined International tournaments in Induction & Weed out protocols irrespective of any age.
- d. Athletes identified for NCOE from defined National tournaments in Induction & Weed out protocols.
